RE: SUSPENSION OF FACE TO FACE LEARNING AND TEACHING

Pursuant to the Presidential Public Order No 2 on COVID 19 declared on Friday the 26th March 2021, Alupe University College shall be closed indefinitely until otherwise directed by the President with effect from 29th March 2021

The following shall therefore be followed in Alupe University College following that Public Order on COVID 19:

1. Face to face teaching and learning is suspended throughout the University College.
2. All students to be off campus at the time this Order is in force.
3. Online teaching and learning shall commence as soon as possible once the Deputy Principal ARSA and the Deans Committee produces a timetable, but not later than 9th April 2021.
4. All CODs to identify courses that can be taught online at this time and be included in the timetable which shall be shared with the students.
5. All practical courses needing the use of laboratories are also suspended.
6. School of Health Sciences students on hospital rotations shall continue with these rotations in hospitals.
7. Online teaching and learning shall be done with students out of campus
8. All staff shall be on duty as guided by the memo from the Principal's office of 17th March 2021

All staff and students are advised to comply with MOH COVID 19 guidelines at all time while at place of work or at home or any place of residence.

All staff are encouraged to get the COVID 19 vaccination.
