**Duties and Responsibilities**

1. Teach and assess course in one's discipline at both undergraduate and graduate level;
2. Supervise undergraduate projects and other experiential learning programme;
3. Supervise dissertations/theses at graduate level;
4. Develop undergraduate and graduate courses;
5. Initiate, promote, and participate in research projects;
6. Participate in academic leadership programmes;
7. Provide professional and community services and initiate linkages and fundraising; and
8. Carry out administrative and other duties and responsibilities as may be assigned.

**Criteria for Promotion**

1. a) Must have a Doctorate degree or its academic equivalent from a recognized accredited institution.
2. Must have at least 3 years of teaching and/ or research experience at university level since becoming a Lecturer

3. A minimum of twenty – four (24) publication points and two (2) points from abstracts presented at conferences since appointment to the position of lecturer
4. Must have supervised graduate degree candidates
5. Must have attended and contributed at learning conferences, seminars or workshops
6. Must show evidence of continued research and evaluated effective teaching and success in student supervision
7. Must show evidence of contribution to university life through active participation in department matters, students' academic advising, School and University meetings, committee membership and other University College related activities.;
8. a) Must be recognized and registered with relevant regulatory body where applicable
- b) Must show evidence of having developed proposals that have attracted funding.
